Dear friends,

Our meetings for worship have continued via Zoom technology these past three months. As noted in previous reports, corporate worship is available Sundays at 9:00 and 11:00, and on Tuesdays at 6:30. We piloted an in person worship on May 23, following appropriate public health safeguards and it was successful with 40 people in attendance. After discussion with several of our committees and at the June Business meeting, we agree to provide both zoom and in person worship Sundays at 11:00, starting June 27<sup>th</sup>. At first, following city and state guidance, we dispensed with any restrictions, allowing people to determine for themselves whether to socially distance or use masks. Subsequently, at our July business meeting, we revised our protocols to strongly request and encourage friends to wear masks in worship, as a means to insure that people who feel most vulnerable feel protected.

We held three meetings for worship with a concern for business this quarter, all by zoom.

Last Quarter, I provided detailed information on the many activities that friends in Brooklyn can participate in. I will not repeat it here, but sufficient to say, that on line activities remain and friends are beginning to gather in person in different ways.

We are saddened to report the death of Glenn Bibler, a long term member of our community. We will held him and his family in the Light.
